

Upon completion of the Ministerial Studies
Diploma (including all three levels of study), you

You will have mastered the basic Bible content (Old and New Testament), theological principles, and practical ministry skills for service in a church leadership position.

Please note: Ministerial credentials are not issued by Global University. This program provides academic training, not ministerial recognition.

♦ Level One (Certified Minister)

Upon completion, you will possess a working knowledge of Bible study methods, New Testament content, and Pentecostal doctrine, and so, the basic skills needed to begin serving in a ministerial role in the local church.

♦ Level Two (Licensed Minister)

Upon completion, you will possess a mastery of specified Bible content, systematic theology, and ministry skills.

♦ Level Three (Ordained Minister)

Upon completion, you will possess mastery of several of the more difficult books of the Bible, advanced theological concepts, and administrative skills required for ministerial roles.

Bible and Doctrine Diploma

Upon completion, you will have a basic knowledge of Bible and theology that will help you in lay ministry roles such as Sunday school instruction, in sharing the gospel with friends and neighbours, and in your personal devotional life. This diploma is designed to prepare you for Christian living.
